In this lesson we want you to write your own personal Eulogy. A Eulogy is a speech or piece of writing that praises someone or something highly, typically someone who has just died. In other words, if you were to die today, what would people who know you say about you? You are writing about yourself based upon what you believe people would say about you. Did you bring out the best in a person? What was your personality like? Did they know you as a Christian, etc. *Remember, this is what people will say about you, not what you want them to say.*

Lesson 34 Mentor Instructions



Mentors, this is not an assignment to depress your student(s). It is designed to help them recognize how they are living their lives and the impact and influence (negative or positive) they have on the people they encounter on a daily, weekly, or monthly basis either at home, Church, School or in the Community.

Suggestions:

- Have the student write it and share it with you.
- This could be an activity that the student shares with an audience (peers, family, etc..)
- Make sure they are writing and thinking clearly about their lives.
- Allow them to reflect upon their life. Tell them to sit quietly before they begin writing.
- Help them to think about the people they are closest to. Would they even know they are a Christian?

The goal of this assignment is to have the students reflect and think about how they are living their lives currently and what changes they may want to make in order for their Eulogy to bring glory to God.
